Players: Write your name in a rectangle				Course rules: Roll the die. If using a regular 10-sided die, each number counts as a tenth. For example: rolling a 3 would be .3 and counts as one stroke. If your roll meets the goal, you make a hole in one! If not, continue rolling the die until the goal is achieved. Lowest score wins.
Hole	Par			
1	1			The decimal < 1.
2	6			The decimal = ½.
3	4			The decimal's numerator is even.
4	6			The decimal < 2/5.
5	6			The decimal > 3/5.
6	1			The decimal has a ten for a denominator.
7	4			The decimal > ½.
8	4			The decimal < ½.
9	3			The decimal's numerator is odd.
